Welcome! Once you become eligible for insurance benefits, a “Summary Plan Description” of member benefits will be mailed to your home address. Please take the time to review the benefits which you will be entitled to as an eligible member of the Plan.

Coverage will begin once the Benefit Office receives copies of birth certificate(s), social security card(s) for you and/or dependent(s). A copy of the divorce decree is required if you must provide medical coverage for dependent(s). If you are single and will have covered dependent(s), visit our website at www.stllaborers.com, and download the “Dependent Custody Letter” located under the Benefit Forms tab. Return the form to our office at the address listed below on this letter.

Your benefits include medical, dental, hearing aid, vision care benefits and a member assistance program (MAP) for alcohol, drug and psychological assistance, a prescription drug program, weekly temporary disability benefits and death benefits for you and your dependent(s). Generally, your employer pays the entire cost of these benefits for you while you are employed and coverage remains as long as you meet the eligibility requirements set forth in the Plan.

Please note that the benefits provided by this Plan (except death benefits) are not available for charges attributed to any accident, injury or illness arising from your employment or self-employment, regardless of whether your employment or self-employment is your primary occupation, or for charges arising from an occupational accident, injury or illness for your dependent(s).

As an eligible member, you have the responsibility to inform the Benefit Office if any changes occur with your address, dependent coverage (i.e., marriage, divorce, separation, dependent status, etc.) or when anyone suffers from an injury or illness for which a third party may be required to compensate the covered person(s).
